The time frame for all workshops will be from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon.



Spirituality, in general, can be described as the values, beliefs, attitudes, actions and behaviors that characterize a person's relationship with God and other people. But for Christians, we understand that spirituality is about living a life that is guided by the Holy Spirit, characterized by faith, hope, love and service, and lived out within the community of believers.

There is no step-by-step, checklist approach to spirituality. It flows from our personal, human longing for a deeper relationship with the Creator, and is thus a personal, unique journey for each of us.
