This is why we celebrate Mother's Day:

Stephanie Decker heard the warning that Friday afternoon, March 2, 2012. A tornado was thundering its way across Indiana. So she gathered her two children-Dominic, 8, and Reese, 5-in the basement of their threestory-house. Stephanie huddled them under a comforter and laid her own body on top of them. The 175-mile-perhour storm hit like a freight train, leveling the house. Her son and daughter were fine—but Stephanie could not move. She knew immediately that she was severely injured; she texted a loving goodbye message to her husband, a teacher at the local high school. When the tornado finally passed, Dominic ran for help and a neighbor rushed over and found Stephanie in the rubble. Both of her legs had been severed. The neighbor fashioned two tourniquets to stop the bleeding and sheriff's officers rushed Stephanie to a hospital.

When she woke up after surgery, her husband Joe told her, "The kids are here because of you. You're going to be here for your kids, and you will get to see them grow up."

Stephanie Decker says she is not a hero; the simple title "mom" fits her just fine. "Really, it was instinct and it was protecting my children. Once I knew they were safe, I knew I could rest. If anything were to happen to me, as long as I knew my children were safe, I was OK with that.

The love of a mom, like Stephanie, mirrors the love that is the heart of Jesus's Gospel. The love that Jesus demands of us, his disciples, is to love one another as he has loved us: to put ourselves second for the sake of others, to seek our joy in bringing joy to others, to honor and cherish others simply because they are, like us, sons and daughters of God. The love of Christ endures throughout the most painful and difficult steps of life's journey. Discipleship is centered on the "instinct" of a mother's love for her children; we as disciples of Jesus find our joy completed in our ability to bring joy to others, in imitation of the Risen Jesus.
