From the Pastor's Desk

This past Tuesday morning the gospel reading for mass was from the Gospel of John 10: 22-30. In this passage John said that Jesus was in the temple area during the Feast of Dedication. I was not sure what the Feast of Dedication was so I looked it up and discovered that we know this feast today as Hanukah which our Jewish brothers and sisters celebrate.

Hanukah commemorates the "rededication of the temple" in Jerusalem. Four centuries before Christ, Syrian Greeks occupied Israel and, over time, devastated Jerusalem. Then, in the year 165 B.C., Judah Maccabee led a revolt of Jewish warriors that successfully drove the Syrian-Greeks out of Israel and reclaimed Jerusalem. In a weeklong festival, the temple was rededicated to the worship of God. The victory of the Maccabees is remembered at Hanukah (which means "dedication"), celebrated each year around our Christmas observance. The centerpiece of the Feast of Dedication is the lighting of the eight candles of the menorah over the eight nights of the festival.

We as a faith community during this Easter season in our scripture readings during mass are hearing again the stories of the beginnings of our own "temple": the Church of the Risen Jesus. Let us make this a time for us to celebrate, to celebrate the "dedication" of our own parish community. To ask "Now What?" can we do to renew and refocus our efforts to do the "works of the Father": to give voice to God's call to reconciliation and peace in our parish's ministries of prayer, education, compassion and service.
