Fr. Dominic is an excellent speaker. Some of you may remember him from years past when he helped out here in the parish.

As part of our efforts to increase security here at the parish, we have recently installed cameras on the grounds. We now have 24/7 monitoring of the Church and Parish Center.

It has come to my attention that a number of individuals have been on the parish grounds soliciting money from parishioners as you leave the Church on Sundays. Our outreach staff and public safety individuals ask that you do not give them cash.

These individuals should be directed to members of the Parish Staff, or Friars. As you are aware, we have a full service outreach center, St. Francis House. This is the appropriate resource to help those in need.

On November 12th the second collection is for the fund for Retired Religious. Please note that the retired Friars of our Province do not receive funds from this collection. It is mostly used to support retired Religious Sisters. Having said that, I ask that you please be as generous as possible.

Finally, we recently purchased cards for the pews that contain the parts of the Mass, Gloria, Creed, etc. Some of these were already damaged and consequently by mistake a member of our cleaning company threw all of them out. We will be replacing them in the near future.

some answers to your frequently asked questions (FAQ'S) below:

What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift

What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift and return the tag taped to the present by the request date.

Do Not Wrap the present

What is the tag for? The tag is very important as it indicates the individual information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sorted and distributed. When you get the tag home, copy the information down or take a picture to ensure that if you lose the tag you still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

Where do I drop the Present? On November 19th, St. Francis of Assisi will place a Christmas Angel Giving Tree on display in the vestibule of the church; gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily. <u>Presents must be returned by Sunday, December 10th.</u> (NO Exceptions)

Can I give additional items than those requests on the tag? Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.
