

The O.F.M. Franciscan Friars from six US provinces met simultaneously this week, and on Wednesday afternoon voted to become one US province. This proposed merger now has to be approved by the Minister General and General Definitorium of the O.F.M. Franciscans in Rome.

If the merger is approved by Rome, the actual canonical erection and functioning of the one Province will not happen for several more years (2022-2023). Much legal, financial, and personnel work has to be done before the new Province can become a reality.

The impact on the current ministries of Holy Name Province remains to be seen.
