We are still in the process of accepting donations for the Parish Annual Appeal. As of this week, donations and pledges total approximately \$134,000. My deepest appreciation to all who have given so far.

A special word of gratitude to a couple who donated an additional \$100,000 in one gift. They wish to remain anonymous. However, they have given permission for us to use their gift as a challenge gift. To challenge other parishioners to match their gift through additional gifts.

As of now only 10 percent of the members of the parish have given or pledged a gift for the appeal this year. And so I ask, if you have not yet given, would you now consider a gift to help respond to this couples' challenge?

We are going to need every dollar we can raise as the initial bids to replace the air conditioning system in the Parish Center is now in the \$200,000 range, and possibly going as high as \$300,000.

We have also received an estimate of \$500,000 to bring the system up to current standards and subsequently make it more efficient.

Some good news, after years of requesting a Catholic Charities Psychological Counselor from their Diocesan Counseling program, I have received word that we will have a counselor on the parish grounds one day a week, available for parishioners in need, beginning in January. These counselors work on what is called a sliding scale fee basis, charging what a person can afford.

This sliding scale based fee is made possible through the funding of the annual Catholic Charity Collection, taking place next weekend. I ask that you please be as generous as possible in that second collection.

I am happy to announce that Bishop Burbidge's operation for prostate cancer was successful and he is recovering nicely.

Finally, my apologies for having two charitable organizations soliciting in the Church last weekend. That happened because of a mix-up in scheduling.

The Parish Council, upon my recommendation, decided this past year that we would permit only one charitable fundraiser at a time at weekend Masses. Weather permitting the organization's tables will be located outside of the lobby.




