I am pleased to inform you that we will now have the services of a Psychological Counselor on **Tuesdays each week**, beginning in mid-February. **Peter Drabbant**, a member of the Catholic Charities Counseling Services, will be on site from **10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. here at the Parish Office.**

We have been trying for several years to obtain the services of a Counselor for those parishioners who could benefit from these services.

Peter is a licensed counselor who specializes providing individual therapy for such issues as depression, anxiety, obsessive compulsive disorders, scrupulosity, anger issues, substance abuse, and marriage counseling.

He will also be available to conduct group sessions for a variety of issues.

Fees for Peter's services will be on a sliding scale depending on what a person can afford. Insurance is accepted.


Catholic Charities has sponsored a Counseling program in Northern Virginia for a number of years. Our parish will be the first to have a Counselor, on site, in the Eastern Prince William County area.

He will begin this service in mid-February but appointments can now be made.

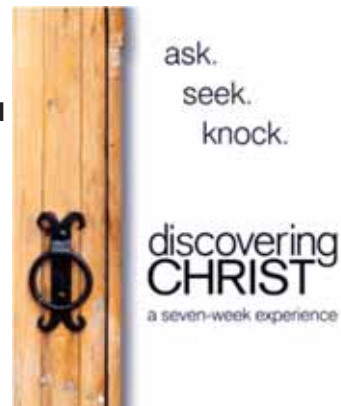

February 8th is the Feast day of St. Bakhita and the National Day of Prayer against Human Trafficking.

Saint Josephine Bakhita (1869-February 8, 1947)

Saint Josephine Bakhita was born in 1869 in the Darfur region of Sudan in Africa. She was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery at the age of 9 and forced to walk 600 miles to Southern Sudan. She was harshly treated, chained, and brutally scared and tattooed on her face and torso by her captives and masters. She was eventually sold in her teens as a servant in the household of an Italian diplomat stationed in Khartoum, Sudan. The diplomat returned to Italy in the early 1880s where he gave St. Josephine to a family friend by the name of Augusto Michieli. She became the nanny of Michieli's daughter, and St. Josephine would take the child to and from Catholic school run by the Canossian Sisters. It was here at the school that St. Josephine listened intently to the catechetical instruction provided to the children.



This prepared St. Josephine to become a Catholic, and she was baptized in 1890. Sometime after her baptism, the Michieli's were preparing to travel to Africa when St. Josephine refused to go with them. She found refuge with the Canossian Sisters who pleaded St. Josephine's case before the Italian government. The ruling of the courts claimed that since slavery had been outlawed in Italy that St. Josephine was a free woman from the time, she first arrived in Italy years before.

St. Josephine stayed with the Sisters of Charity in Venice and became a nun; taking her vows in 1896.

Despite being sold like property numerous times, she is noted for her gracious manner, and the forgiveness she extended to all those who enslaved, beat, and tortured her during St. Josephine's captivity. Ironically, the name Bakhita, which was given to her by her kidnappers, means "fortunate." Her name ultimately reflects the later part of her life when she was freed from slavery and illustrates how the Holy Spirit can create good from evil. She was Beatified in 1992 and was Canonized in 2000 by Pope John Paul II.

Her famous quote is: **"Be good, love the Lord, pray for those who do not know Him. What a great grace it is to know God!"**

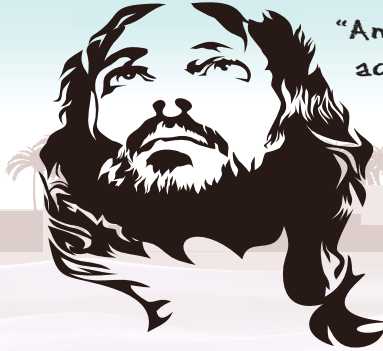
