A number of parishioners have asked me when we will be able to return to a full schedule of weekend Masses

As of now the Governor has indicated that the State will "lift all restrictions on social distancing "the weekend" of Memorial Day.

Bishop Burbidge will be meeting with his "COVID" Advisory Team. He will then release a statement as to when Churches in the diocese can resume a normal schedule of Masses.

Depending on the Bishop's direction, we will most likely resume a full schedule of "on site" Masses (no reservations needed) the weekend of June 12th.

Please note that the new schedule of Masses will be different than in pre-COVID times. We will now have an 8:00 a.m. Mass, a 9:30 a.m. Mass, an 11:00 a.m. Mass, and a 12:30 p.m. Spanish Mass. The 5:30 p.m. Saturday and 5:30 p.m. Sunday evening Masses will continue as in the past.

We will also continue to live stream one of the weekend liturgies for parishioners who are homebound because of illness or age.

It should be noted that once social distancing restrictions are lifted, the Bishop will most likely lift the dispensation from the obligation to attend weekend Mass.

There may be exceptions for those who have a physical condition that could be compromised by being in proximity of individuals who have not been vaccinated.

# Sister Parish School in Peru Needs Our Help



This year we are again helping students to attend Santa Anna Parish Schools. COVID has compounded the poverty of our brothers and sisters so that the need is even greater. The parents have no jobs and no government help. But the importance of education requires that school continues. The scholarships this year range from \$90 to \$420 for the year.
