St. Francis of Assisi parish has supported the Un-Trim-A-Tree Program for more than 18 years; providing assistance for families in need in Dumfries, Triangle, and Quantico. This year St. Francis of Assisi will also be providing monetary donations to the following agencies: Birthright, Project Rachel and Gabriel, and Migration and Refugee of Catholic Charities. Trees decorated with tags are now on display in the vestibule of the church for you to take a tag or two or more. To assist you in the process we have some answers to your frequently asked questions (FAQ'S) below:

What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift and return the tag taped to the present by the requested date. <u>Do Not Wrap the present</u>

What is the tag for? The tag is very important as it indicates the individual's information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sorted and distributed. When you pull a tag from one of the trees, copy the information down or take a picture of the tag to ensure that if you lose the tag you will still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

Where do I drop the Present? Gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily.

Presents must be returned by Sunday, December 12th.

(NO Exceptions)

Can I give additional items than those requested on the tag? Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.

Some Frequently Asked Questions:

Will you need to download software, open an account, and have another set of passwords to remember? Nope. Flocknote emails and newsletter simply go to the email account you designate when you sign up. Text messages will go to the mobile number you designate when you sign up.

Is this another personal email system? Nope. It is meant to support group communications. And we can establish any groups we like. The Lectors have a group, the Craft Ministry has a group, Care for Creation has several groups (for the ministry members and another for folks who want to stay connected with the group's newsletters.)

Can I reply to messages and emails? Can everyone read my replies and comments? Yes, you can reply - that's what makes it a two-way communication tool. Flocknote allows you to mark your replies and comments "private" - in fact, that is the default setting. Only the "group admin" - e.g., the ministry leader who sent the note - will be able to read your comment.

When I sign up will I be able to join parish groups? Yes, that is also part of the sign-up process.

Is this system safe? Flocknote meets all the requirements of the Diocesan Safe Environment program and uses super-secure encryption and TLS protocols.

listed in the bulletin during the Christmas Season.




Votive Candles
