I. Call to Order/Attendance/Opening Prayer

- The meeting was called to order at 9:30AM.
 - Members Present Fr. John O'Connor (Pastor), Dan Sullivan (Chair), Christine Arroyo (Vice-Chair), Joe Burns, Mary Beth Keenan; Clarence Neason, Tom Wood, and Ulli Vaerst.
 - Other Attendees: Dr. Tricia Barber (Principal SFA School), Mary Mahler (Chair, SFA Finance Committee Representing Parish Business Manager), Angelica Silva (Religious Education Coordinator) representing Shelia Noble (Director of Faith Formation) and Francia Salguero (Director of Francis House).
 - Members Not Present John Cipparone, Cecilia Fellner, Tony Mercogliano, Ivan Nazario, and Ryan Steenberge.
- Fr. John led us all in an opening prayer.

II. Pastor's Opening Remarks – Fr. John announced:

- Parish Staffing
 - St. Francis School Dr. Barber is retiring. A selection committee has been formed and will begin work on April 17th to address the issue of hiring a successor. In the interim Elizabeth Reyhel has been appointed Assistant Principal.
 - Parish Staff Lina Morales and Jessica Ulsenheimer have been hired as our new Receptionist and Bookkeeper respectively. Lina is bilingual which will aid in communication with Hispanic parish members.
- Bishop Burbidge's Visit The Sunday March 26th visit was very successful. The Bishop celebrated the 11am mass. At the luncheon after the liturgy celebration the Bishop congratulated Fr. John on his 50th anniversary of ordination.
- Holy Week and Easter Liturgies The response to our liturgies was excellent with over 5000 people attending the Easter Masses. We celebrated two extra unscheduled Masses in the school gym to handle to crowd. We will be adding them to our schedule next year. Traffic was a problem due to the fact commitments made by the Prince William Police for traffic direction were not honored. The Parish will be using the County Sherriff deputies for future events.
- Provincial News During the first two weeks of June the last Holy Name Province Chapter will be held. Please note that during part of this event there will be no Friars in the parish. We will be arranging for clerical support from other parishes in the diocese during this time period. The first Chapter of the new Our Lady of Guadalupe Province will be held this fall.
- Facilities Update Repairs of the AC system in the Parish Center and School have been completed.
 A tree fell on to a neighboring property. A tree service will trim the trees on the perimeter where branches or trees may present a risk.

- III. Chair Remarks Approval of Minutes A motion was made and seconded to approve the March 18, 2023 Minutes. The motion unanimously carried.
- IV. Financial/Facilities Update- Mary Mahler provided the following:
- Financial Status Collections are 88% (up from 84%) of planned budget and improving. On-Line weekly Enhanced Offertory giving is now 40% of our income. We continue to encourage on-line giving to mitigate "summer vacation" shortfalls.
- Facilities We are still getting estimates on the fences for St. Francis School and considering
 putting off the double door project. The sewer system on our property line has experienced some
 back-ups. The Prince William County Service Authority (PWCSA) is working on correcting this
 issue.
- **Diocesan Audit** 2022 Financial Audit is still in progress. Final report has not been received.
- V. SFA School Update Dr. Barber reported the school did very well in Design for Excellence Evaluation either meeting or exceeding all benchmarks. The evaluation team was very complementary to the both the staff and students.

VI. Hispanic Ministry Update -

- All the Lenten, Holy Week, and Easter activities/liturgies were successful, including the live Way of the Cross (Las Cruces) which was dramatized outdoors on Good Friday. Pictures are available in the April 11th SFA e-News. The goal for next year will be to do it as a whole church bilingual.
- Fr. Chris is working with leadership of the following groups for upcoming activities:
 Charismatic Ministry (Eduardo Martinez- formation/catechesis/monitoring); Order of Secular Franciscans; Legion of Mary; and Ladies/Men's Clubs.

VII. Group Reports:

- Religious Education Angelica reported they are considering a time change for Sunday Religious Education (RE) classes to alleviate traffic congestion and also reviewing the registration process and payment options for upcoming year's RE program.
- Strategic Plan Update A draft updated SFA Strategic Plan has been completed by the committee and sent to Dan and Father John for review/comment. The plan will be shared with all members of the Council in the near future for comment/discussion at our next meeting.

VIII. Old Business:

Fall Picnic/Francis Fest – The Pastoral Council will be sponsor. The tentative date will be Sunday, October 8th. We will attempt to make the event more multi-cultural. Francia will coordinate needed volunteers. (See attachment to minutes for specific details/responsibilities).
