### The New and the Old

From the Friars

*"Every scribe who has been instructed in the kingdom of heaven is like the head of a household who brings from his storeroom both the new and the old."* (Matthew 13:52). The new comes first, Jesus' interpretation of the Word and the Will of God.

Pope Francis recently responded to a question of a fellow Jesuit about the negative reaction of some US Catholics to his teaching: "The situation in the United States is not easy: There is a very strong, reactionary attitude. It is organized and shapes the way people belong, even emotionally...I want to remind these people that backwardism is useless, and it is necessary to understand that there is a correct evolution in the understanding of questions of faith and morals." The Pope in essence is paraphrasing Jesus' saying on the new and the old and ultimately calling us back to Jesus' new way.

We need to be clear that Pope Francis has not rejected the "old", he has not changed any doctrines of the Church. He continues to affirm the church's teaching on abortion and gender identity and other issues of faith and morals. What he has done is to remind us, as previous popes have done, that the teachings of the church on faith and morals extend to other areas such as ecology and climate change, racism, immigration, and other issues of peace and justice.

Pope Francis has suggested that our renewal as Christians and as a church begins by accepting a personal invitation from Jesus: "I invite all Christians...to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ...I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day. No one should think that this invitation is not meant for him or her...whenever we take a step towards Jesus, we come to realize that he is already there, waiting for us with open arms." (Apostolic Exhortation, "The Joy of the Gospel, #3). This invitation is the essence of Pope Francis' challenge to the church not only in the US but throughout the word. The challenge is the encounter Jesus each day so that we can truly be the Body of Christ and welcome all "with open arms."


