





Ways to Give and Save on Taxes



Are you a senior (72 years or older) making Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) from a traditional IRA? Would you like to save on your taxes for income earned in 2024?

By shifting your charitable giving to a traditional IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) you can still get a tax break for charitable giving, even if you don't itemize. Or if you do itemize, it may still save you tax dollars.

You pay no income taxes on the gift. The gift does not count as income and will reduce your annual income. The transfer generates neither taxable income nor a tax deduction, so you benefit even if you do not itemize your deductions. The gift may reduce the amount of your Social Security that is taxed and could help lower your Medicare premiums.

Please consider making a Qualified Charitable Distribution to St. Francis this year! The gift helps you lower your taxes and supports your Parish.

Please contact your tax professional for additional information on your specific tax liabilities.
