From the Friars

The message of Easter does not stand in isolation but flows from the proclamation and invitation of Ash Wednesday. Jesus' proclamation began with the words, *"This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand."* Jesus' invitation flows

from this proclamation as we heard on Ash Wednesday: "*Repent and believe in the gospel.*" (Mark 1:15). God's message to us during Lent and especially during Holy Week is that he is with us and "walking with us on the journey of our life." The Easter message is the message of life, even life through death.

We have encountered Jesus in many ways during this season of repentance, of turning to God. As the children with joy and exuberance brought up food for the poor and the needy, we learned to see Jesus in the "least." We have encountered Jesus as we shared soup together and walked the way of his cross each Friday and heard the refrain, "Padre, perdónanos, Father, forgive us." Jesus invites us to receive the gift of God's mercy and forgiveness.

Most of all the message of Easter is a message of joy and hope. We come to God this Easter with our joy but also with our sorrow and heavy burdens. In our darkness we receive the light of Christ and are invited to let our light shine. We are challenged to bring that light to all without judgment or condemnation. We welcome all as God has welcomed all of us, both saints and sinners. So let us give thanks to God for being "at hand" and next to us each day. Let us turn to God so that he may embrace us once again. We respond to God's embrace with the acclamation "Halleluia, Praise God."







Acts of the Apostles: A Church in Crisis, A Listening Church



Fr. Jim Scullion, O.F.M. will be presenting a 6-week bible course on the Acts of the Apostles. The Evangelist Luke wrote a two-volume work, a Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. Acts tells the story of how the story of Jesus continued in the story of the early church. As the early church faced various crises, they were challenged to listen to one another and to listen to the holy Spirit as it both directed and challenged them. Like the early church the



process of synodality ("journeying together") calls us as a church to listen to one another and the holy Spirit. Classes are on Mondays (in the St. Catherine Room) from 9:30 a.m.— 10:45 a.m. on the following dates: April 8th, 22nd, 29th, May 6th, 13th, and 20th. There will be <u>no class April 15th</u>.
