THE PATH TO OUR VISION

Our path forward for this five-year Strategic Plan is organized into seven strategic goals. The first six goals align with those of the Diocese of Arlington Strategic Plan because the needs and wants of the people of the diocese fundamentally reflect the needs and wants of the people of our parish. We found this to be true as we compared the diocesan Strategic Plan with the results and recommendations of the parish focus groups and synods held over the last three years. The seventh pillar "Supporting the Priorities of the Franciscan Order" is special and singular to our parish as we are blessed to be under the auspices of the Order of Franciscans Minor and part of the Franciscans' Our Lady of Guadalupe Province.

Each strategic goal is then supported by an objective. What can you, your family, or the ministries you are a part of do to achieve each objective?

GOAL 1: REVITALIZE EVANGELIZATION AND FAITH FORMATION

We will empower our parishioners to foster a culture of encounter that joyfully attracts people to the Life of Christ and the beauty of his Church. This goal aligns with the values of dignity, peace, hospitality, reconciliation, and stewardship.

Objective 1-1: Improve faith formation/sacramental preparation.

Objective 1-2: Refine RCIA programs.

Objective 1-3: Renew community awareness of St Francis and our mission.

Objective 1-4: Enrich outreach to homebound parishioners.

GOAL 2: CULTIVATE AUTHENTIC DISCIPLESHIP IN CHRIST

We will inspire and form parishioners to follow Jesus and the teachings of his Church so they actively engage in her apostolic mission. This goal aligns with the value of reconciliation.

Objective 2-1: Promote participation by the laity in liturgical and other parish ministries.

Objective 2-2: Encourage and support parishioners in discerning a call to a religious vocation as deacons, priests, or in religious life.

Objective 2-3: Propagate interfaith opportunities semi-annually that support the universal Christ.

GOAL 3: INVIGORATE CATHOLIC EDUCATION FOR ALL

We will nurture adults and students spiritually, intellectually, and socially to positively transform it for the glory of God. This goal aligns with the values of dignity, peace, justice, hospitality, compassion, reconciliation, and stewardship.

Objective 3-1: Revitalize formal educational opportunities of all parish members.

Objective 3-2: Continue to provide full support of goals and objectives of St. Francis School.

Objective 3-3: Provide formal/informal programs for youth not attending St. Francis School.

Objective 3-4: Promote faith educational programs for teenagers and young adults.

Objective 3-5: Strengthen adult education programs with emphasis on sacramental, synodal and historical issues.

GOAL 4: STRENGTHEN PARISH AND FAMILY LIFE

We will build a vibrant parish community where people are welcomed and moved to engage in the sacramental and communal life of the Church. This goal aligns with the values of dignity, peace, justice, hospitality, and compassion.

Objective 4-1: Increase parishioner participation in parish ministries.

Objective 4-2: Renew more opportunities for parishioners to come together in family environments.

Objective 4-3: Create options for parish and family life balance.

Objective 4-4: Provide programs to establish, sustain, and strengthen the connection with the church for people who are away.

Objective 4-5: Provide adequate facilities, as well as administrative and financial management support to achieve the stated goals of this plan.

GOAL 5: FOSTER ONE COMMUNION OF MANY CULTURES

We will foster understanding, respect and appreciation for the different cultural expressions of *Catholicism so as to live as the one Body of Christ.* This goal aligns with the values of dignity, peace, justice, hospitality, and compassion.

Objective 5-1: Encourage ministries to serve the different cultures represented in our parish.

Objective 5-2: Increase awareness and understanding of the many cultures that make up our parish.

Objective 5-3: Seek to blend cross-cultural boundaries.

GOAL 6: DEEPEN OUR COMMITMENT TO CHARITABLE WORKS

We will proclaim the Lord's call to serve the poor so all are inspired to participate in the Works of Mercy. This goal aligns with the values of dignity, peace, justice, and compassion.

Objective 6-1: Assess and intensify our ability to meet the needs of our community.

Objective 6-2: Interact with neighboring religious, governmental, and community organizations quarterly to ensure the needs of all the less fortunate in our community are met .
