**Sister Parish Scholarship Collection
BEGINS APRIL 13, 2024**



The Santa Ana School provides a quality education in a parish where the vast number of families live in poverty and educational opportunities are few. Years of hard-fought economic progress were wiped out by the COVID pandemic and its accompanying economic devastation. Recovery is difficult, but keeping kids in school at Santa Ana provides a path to the future. Each year since 2009 St. Francis has provided full or partial scholarships for children in need of assistance.

When we originally began our work there, the school was just one floor for first through 6th grade. Now the school has grown to include a secondary school and several graduates have gone on to the University.

Since they are in the Southern Hemisphere, their school year begins in March. This year we have been asked to help pay the tuition for 46 children. The cost for an entire year at the secondary school is \$665. The primary school cost is \$600. Most of the children only need help with half of the tuition. In order that more of our parishioners may participate in this ministry, larger scholarships will be divided into two or three parts.

On April 13th, you will see a bulletin board display with photos of the children, directions on how to participate, and envelopes with their name and the requested donation. There will also be a sign-up sheet on the table under the bulletin board display. Please take an envelope and put your name on the sign-up sheet. Return your donation by May 4th, please. Your check should be payable to St. Francis with Sister Parish Scholarship in the lower left-hand corner. If you choose to make your donation on line, you must be sure to note it is for the Sister Parish Scholarship and include the name of the child and the number assigned to them on the envelope.

**Acts of the Apostles:
 A Church in Crisis, A Listening Church**



Fr. Jim Scullion, O.F.M. will be presenting a 6-week bible course on the Acts of the Apostles. The Evangelist Luke wrote a two-volume work, a Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. Acts tells the story of how the story of Jesus continued in the story of the early church. As the early church faced various crises, they were challenged to listen to one another and to listen to the holy Spirit as it both directed and challenged them. Like the early church the process of synodality (“journeying together”) calls us as a church to listen to one another and the holy Spirit. Classes are on Mondays (in the St. Catherine Room) from 9:30 a.m.—10:45 a.m. on the following dates: April 8th, 22nd, 29th, May 6th, 13th, and 20th. There will be no class April 15th.

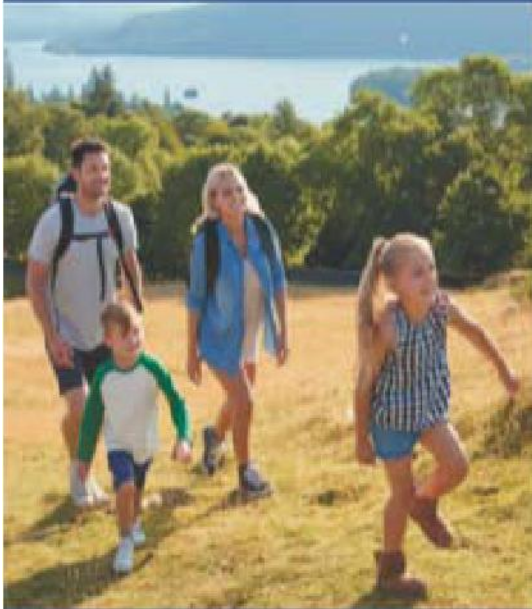
