VII. Financial Update / Overview

Mary provided the following report:

- 1. Fiscal Year 2024 finished June 30. Offertory Collection 90% of budget. Short over \$200k for the year. Total income, includes other donations, 98%. Expenses 95% of budget, \$116k below.
- 2. Council in July approved Parish and School 2025 Budget. Offertory and Income will be the same as last year.
- 3. School income 105% budget, Dr. Barber's fund and daycare higher than expected. Expense 100.3% for the year. Parish contributed \$360k to the budget and donated \$45k to the Diocese for schools.
- 4. \$690k Loan. 8 years remaining. Diocese is a 10 year loan but no principle payments were due during Covid.
- 5. Annual report submitted this past week.
- 6. Finance council approved a new charter. For terms, instituting 3 year terms maximum 3 terms. Now they need to implement.
- 7. Parish made Diocesan Lenten Appeal 103%
